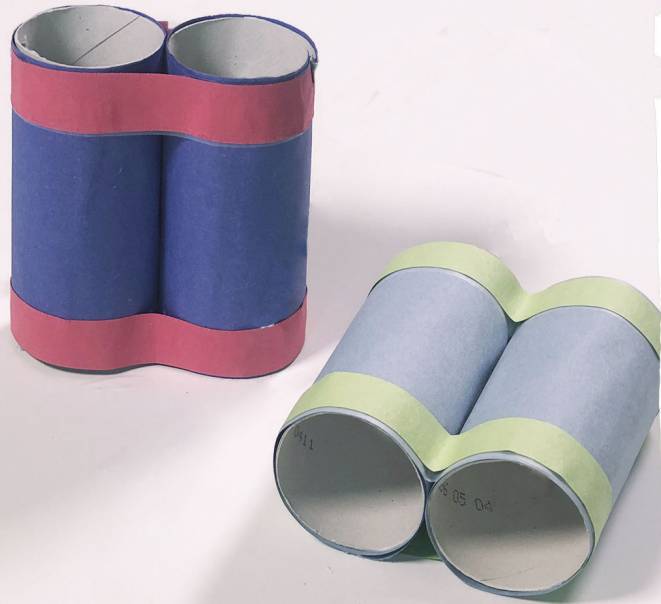




Paper Roll Binoculars

 **Make it Up-cycled**



You and your child will have as much fun making this up-cycled craft as you'll have on the sightseeing adventures that follow.

Supplies

- ✓ Paper towel rolls (cut in half)
- ✓ Construction paper (cut to same length of roll)
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Scotch tape

Instructions

Put several lines of glue on one side of the construction paper.

Line up the cardboard tube lengthwise with the shorter edge of construction paper. Hold paper steady and roll it slowly until the length covers the tube.

Repeat the process above with a second toilet paper roll.

Apply a line of glue at the paper's end seam on each roll; press both seams together to create the binoculars' base.

Use tape to wrap around the top and bottom of binoculars for extra hold.

Glue thin strips of bright paper over the tape.

Go sightseeing!
